

PURPOSE OF THIS MANUAL

This manual is intended to familiarize all personnel with the safe operation and maintenance procedures for the following Southwire Tools and Equipment: SIMpullTM Cradle.



DESCRIPTION OF OPERATION

The SIMpullTM Cradle is a unique stackable cradle designed to be used with the Southwire SIMpullTM Reel. With a base that will accommodate either a standard narrow pallet truck or forklift, the SIMpullTM Cradle can be easily transported to and from or around any jobsite. With designed features to accommodate both 51" and 61" SIMpullTM Reels. The SIMpullTM Cradle can handle all your logistical needs, safely and efficiently.

IDENTIFICATION

- 1. Base Weldment
- 2. Fix Pin Weldment
- 3. Cross Bar Weldment
- 4. Reel Lock Pin
- 5. Cross Bar Lock Pin
- 6. 51" Reel Lock Pin

SETUP AND OPERATION

- 1. Always wear gloves, eye protection and hard hat when working with SIMpull™ Cradle.
- 2. If loading a 51" SIMpull™ Reel, ensure the 51" pin (6) is installed into the 51" pin location prior to loading the reel onto cradle.
- 3. Pull pin (5) and swing cross bar weldment away to allow access for SIMpullTM Reel to roll onto cradle (Fig 1).
- 4. Push spring lock tabs to the side and pull Reel Lock Pins (4) on each side of cradle (Fig 2).
- 5. Ensure cradle loading path is free from debris to ensure SIMpull™ Reel rolls easily across the cradle.
- 6. Roll reel onto the cradle and position to the extreme back position, swing Cross Bar Weldment (3) back to starting point (Fig 3) and insert Cross Bar Lock Pin (5) to keep reel secured in place (Fig 4).
- 7. Slide Reel Lock Pin (4) towards the reel to lock into place (Fig 5). If rib on the reel obstructs the complete insertion of the Reel Lock Pin (4), remove Reel Lock Pin (4) and insert into other pinning location to the left or right. Pin retainers are spring loaded and will have to be pulled to the side to insert the Reel Locking Pin (4) (Fig 6).
- 8. SIMpull™ Cradle can be moved by pallet truck (Fig 7) or by forklift (Fig 8) using one of the two sets of fork pockets on the cradle.





INSPECTION

- 1. Inspect all welds to ensure weldment is in working order.
- 2. Inspect all pins to ensure they are in working order.
- 3. Inspect pin receivers to ensure the springs are intact and in working order.
